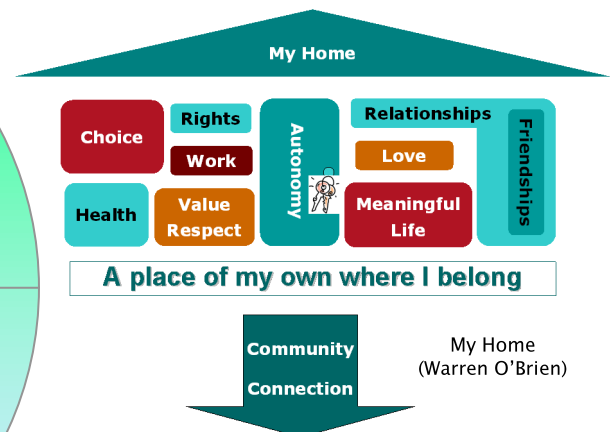
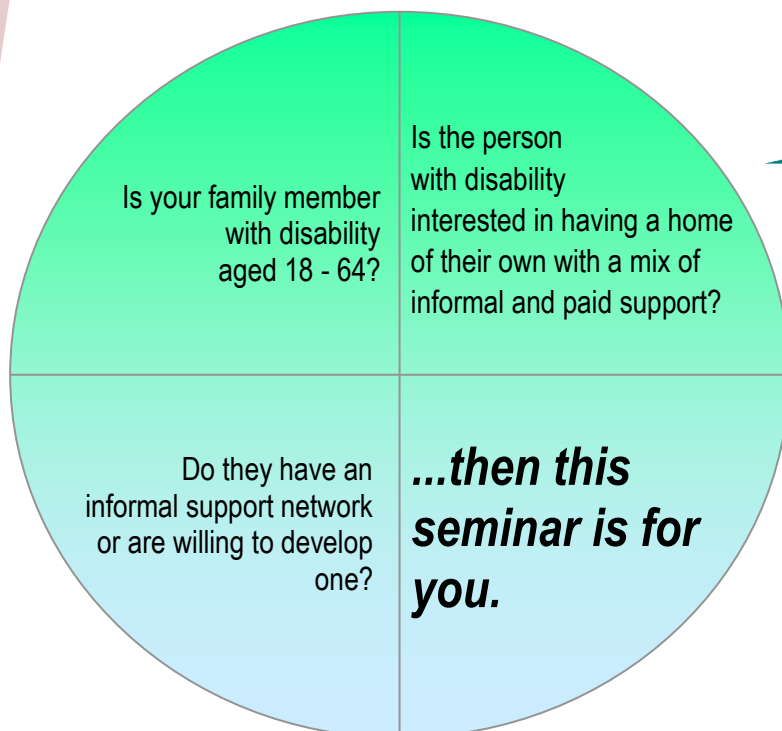
## Have you heard about the Supported Living Fund and want to know more?
