Family Advocacy is a state wide, not for profit disability advocacy organisation that works with families to promote and defend the rights and interests of people who have a developmental disability. This is achieved by strengthening the advocacy role and influence of families so that they can speak out with, and on behalf of their own family member, or for people with developmental disability more broadly. Family Advocacy also undertakes systemic advocacy on issues that act as barriers for people with disability.

We are seeking someone experienced in systemic social change initiatives, from a marketing and communications perspective. A strong background in writing, design, campaign and disability would enable you to hit the ground running and make a real difference as part of a focussed and committed team.

What you will be doing:

- Managing websites and interactive technologies;
- Supporting workshops, seminars and events;
- Building links to CALD and ATSI families with a person with disability, and supporting organisations
- Develop and manage a wide range of resource materials, including brand management

What you will need to succeed:

Essential:

- A commitment to people with developmental disability living ordinary, typical lives, embedded in their families, wider networks and the community.
- Mastery of a range of technologies including website, graphic design, social media and webinar software
- Excellent communication skills written, verbal including presentations.

- Strong interpersonal skills
- Knowledge of issues experienced by people with disability
- A tertiary qualification in communications, media or marketing, or equivalent experience

- Knowledge of advocacy principles and a commitment to working within these.
- Awareness of, and a commitment to, the principles of Social Role Valorisation, <u>or</u> a willingness to gain such understanding and commitment.
